

FREE THIS SUMMER

Weekend Meals & Snacks for Your Child through the Brookings Backpack Project

This summer the Brookings Backpack Project (BBP) will provide a **free weekend supply of kid-friendly meals and snacks** to school-age children and youth (Head Start through 12th grade) who might not have enough food resources at home. The food will be given to participating families at the **Back Pack Packing Site at 228 2nd Street South – the corner of 2nd Street and Airport Avenue**. Bags may be picked up Thursday from noon until 6:00 pm and will **start Thursday, June 2nd** and continue until school begins again in the fall. **There are NO eligibility requirements to participate.**

To register your child in BBP Summertime:

- 1. Complete the consent form below.** List all of your school-age children (Head Start through 12th grade). This information will be shared only with BBP Summertime staff and volunteers.
- 2. Cut off and return the consent form to one of your children’s schools before the end of the school year.** Or, if school is already out for the summer, give the form to a BBP volunteer at the Packing Site or mail to Brookings Backpack Project, PO Box 8054, Brookings, SD 57006 or call the number listed below to make arrangements to register for the program.
- 3. Begin picking up your children’s food at the site during the times listed above at the pick-up site.**
