

Brookings Driver's Education Spring Registration 2021

Read Carefully Before Completing Registration ... Check all dates... Students MUST ATTEND 30 hours of class which means they can miss only one class and that must be made up! No exceptions!

If students are in after school activities in the spring this program may not work for them because the driving portion will be after school for 6 days.

Registration closes **February 26th**. The total cost of \$285.00 for the Drivers Education program is due the first day of class.

Space is limited for this spring session so please register promptly.

Brookings current 9th-12th graders have first priority and we fill open slots with current 8th graders if there are any openings after 9th- 12th graders have registered in the order registration forms are received.

Please remember when signing up that students are required to attend all days of class plus 6 days of driving and must pass both to receive their DE passing certificate.

Class room dates March 12, 13, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 29, 30, 31, April 1, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16. (April 19th is a make-up date) Weekdays we will meet from **7:00 to 8:00 a.m.** and **Saturdays 8:00 to 10:00 a.m.** at the High School CTE building. There is a bus to take students to MMS after morning class if any 8th graders get into the spring class.

Sessions of driving times will begin after the school day. Session times will be given to students during the classroom portion for them to bring home. Please check schedules carefully for any conflicts before selecting a session driving time. You MUST select multiple sessions that work in order for times to work out for everyone.

2021 Spring Driver's Education Policies

Conduct...All participants are expected to abide by the rules, regulations, and directions provided by the course instructors. Failure to do so will subject participants to dismissal from the Driver's Education program.

Certificate....Students will receive a certificate of completion for licensure and insurance purposes upon successful completion of all classroom and driving hours. Students who do not complete 100% of the time required with a passing grade will not receive a passing certificate.

Refunds...will **NOT** be given to students who do not successfully complete the course of study (classroom and driving) due to unsuccessful performance, misconduct, absences, or because the student's family changes their schedule. **Please be sure to confirm your spring schedules before registering for session.**
