

Read Carefully Before Completing Registration...Check all dates...Students MUST ATTEND 30 hours of classroom which means they can miss only 1 class and that must be made up on the make up day! No Exceptions! Driving times will usually be scheduled in a six-day block between 4 and 8 p.m. weeknights. If this does not work for your student this fall session will not fit their needs. Driving time options will be sent home during the first week of class.

In order to reduce handling forms and money I am asking that you register your student online. Once you are notified that your student has been accepted into the class you will send the \$285 fee the first day we meet. **No money will be turned in at the office.**

It is VERY important that we have good communication and that everyone follows through on the dates/times they are signed up for. Read the information carefully. Be sure your student can meet the required attendance policies before signing them up for the class. If you know they cannot drive weekdays after school then please do not sign them up. Our drivers are not able to work around all the extra-curricular schedules.

Available slots will be filled for the class with upperclassmen first – 12th, 11th, 10th, 9th, and then 8th. Time/date stamps will be used to determine order of registration within each grade.

Fall Session August 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 16, 17, 18, 19, 20 with the make-up day on the 23rd. Classes will meet from 7:00 to 10:00 a.m. for a total of 30 hours. Classes will be held at the CTE building at the high school.
